I love Christmas – but we get there too early.

Christmas puddings on the shelves in September, homes being decorated the moment the pumpkins have been thrown in the bin on Novembe 1st and don't even get me started on Creme Eggs on Boxing Day! But this isn 't about me being some kind of Scrooge I love it all.

But when we rush to Christmas, we miss out Advent.

Advent (this year beginning on December 1st) is several things at once. It is when the Church recalls God's people waiting for a Saviour – the world being prepared for the birth of Jesus. But it is also when the Church remembers that God 's promise is that Christ will come again, at the end of all things. So it is a reminder that no matter what happens, all things shall be woven together and made perfect when the time is right.

But there's an idea we might call 'Middle Advent.' Not just that we were waiting for the Messiah two thousand years ago; or that he will come again in g lory at the end; but that in every single moment, God is coming to us. We are so rarely aware of it, distracted by work, by the challenges we face—so many things. This is as true for me a Priest, as it is for everyone.

Perhaps, this Advent, before the glitz and celebration of Christmas, we might stop. Clear some space. Turn off the noise. Sit and breathe. And become aware of the movements of the mind, the heart, the soul within us. Christ longs to be born in each one of us right now ... and now ... and now. When we find he is with us in every moment, it opens up a fountain of joy, hope and strength that will buoy us up as we return to everything we switched off for a moment.

I pray for each and every one of you a blessed and peaceful Advent, and a sweet and joyous Christmas.



Slow cooker fudge by Justine Pattison

The slow cooker gently melts everything together, giving fantastic, velvety results. No more worrying about boiling sugar to the right temperature!

Makes 24 squares, a really tasty Christmas gift!

Ingredients

100g double cream; 1 tsp vanilla extract; 75g soft light brown sugar or light musovado sugar; 320g caramel flavoured chocolate broken into squares Method

Pour the cream into the slow cooker pot and stir through the vanilla extract and sugar. Scatter the chocolate pieces on top (avoid the edges of the slow cooker) and do not stir.

Cover and cook on low for 25–30 minutes, or until the chocolate has melted.

Meanwhile, line the base and sides of a 900g/2lb loaf tin with baking paper or a paper loaf tin liner.

.Remove the pot from the slow cooker and stir the mixture vigorously with a wooden spoon or silicone spatula until smooth and creamy. Pour into the prepared tin and smooth the surface. Leave to cool for 20 minutes, then cover the tin with a piece of kitchen paper, cling film or foil and place in the fridge to set for several hours or overnight.

Turn the set fudge out onto a board. Peel off and discard the paper. Cut the fudge into 24 small squares with a sharp knife. Place in a lidded container, layering with more baking paper so the pieces don't stick together. The fudge will last for several days if kept in the fridge.

Recipe Tips

This recipe uses caramel-flavoured chocolate, sometimes called golden caramel chocolate, blonde or gold chocolate. If your chocolate weighs up to 345g, it will still work perfectly, so feel free to add the additional amount. You can also make the fudge with plain white chocolate, but it won't have such a fudgy flavour. Don't use milk chocolate filled with caramel, as it won't give the same results. Light soft brown muscovado sugar will give a slightly richer flavour to the fudge. Make sure you use vanilla extract, not vanilla essence, for best results.

Using a loaf tin to make the fudge will give you the right-sized pieces. A 900g/2lb loaf tin will have dimensions roughly 20cm/8in long, 10cm/4in wide and 7cm/2¾in high.



SAFEGUARDING WITHIN THE CHURCH

You will, no doubt, have seen in the media recently the shocking and appalling results of the Makin Review into historical abuse within the Church of England, which led to the resignation of the Archbishop of Canterbury, and which will continue to have implications for the future of the Church.

On behalf of all the Churches and all the people of the Benefice, I wish to express our own profound sense of shame and anger at what has been revealed. The Church should, at the very least, be a place where each and every person is safe from harm, and where peace and joy may be found.

We wish to let you all know that each of the parishes within this Benefice has a designated Parish Safeguarding Officer, and we meet on a quarterly basis to review Safeguarding policy; every officer of every Church has completed all required training with regard to Safeguarding; and every single one of them has also had a DBS check done, or this will be done in the very near future as we complete the process of making sure we have done everything we can to ensure safety. We also have ensured that Safeguarding information is readily visible in each Church within the Benefice, and it is an item on every agenda of every PCC meeting in every parish.

If anybody has any concerns regarding a child or vulnerable adult in relation to Church activities, please contact the Diocese of Norwich Safeguarding Team at safeguarding@dioceseofnorwich.org — alternatively you can speak to a member of the team on 01603 882345; but in case of emergency, you can also contact Norfolk County Council Children's Services at 0344 800 8020.

Safeguarding is the responsibility of each and every one of us, a lesson which sadly the Church of England still needs to learn. Here in the Harling and Guiltcross Benefice, we will continue to strive to keep everyone as safe as we can.

THE GARDEN IN DECEMBER

Outside taps: Turn them off inside if you can, if not insulate them. There could be some severe frosts.

Lawns: The normal advice was not to mow between late October and mid- March, because the grass would have stopped growing. With global warming that has changed, and lawns still need some TLC from time to time. If it needs a trim, keep the blades of the mower at least an inch high, and don't cut if the grass is either frozen or waterlogged. Remove leaves which have gathered to let the grass see light and breathe.

Trees and shrubs including Roses: Continue to plant bare-root plants – these can be purchased until mid to late March. Stake trees to prevent rocking in the wind.

The general rule is that birch and Japanese maples don't need pruning, but if it is necessary this is the month to do it. Their sap starts rising much sooner than other deciduous trees, so any later they may bleed allowing fungus and viruses to get into them.

Plant new deciduous hedging: bare root is available now until early March at a fraction of the cost of pot grown plants. My beech hedge at the front of my house was purchased mail order from Glebe Farm Hedging based in Langham near Colchester as was my mixed tapestry hedge in the rear garden. Google them if you're interested.

Cuttings: Take hard wood cuttings of shrubs and trees, including gooseberries, blackcurrants, figs, olives and mulberries.

Prune: deciduous shrubs such as Flowering Currant, Philadelphus, and Deutzia. Thin them out by removing a few branches at ground level.

Plant: Plant or move shrubs, trees and hedging. Keep them watered if necessary until Mother

Nature takes over – there will be dry spells with cold winds.

Short biennials: Remove any fallen leaves to prevent low plants from being covered.

Bulbs: It is not too late to plant tulips and daffodil bulbs – watch out for generous reductions in the garden centres. Check potted bulbs planted in September and move any that are ready to a greenhouse or a cool room.

Vegetables: Continue to harvest any that are ready. Pigeon proof your brassicas with netting. Only dig parsnips as you need them, they taste sweeter after a frost.

Fruit Trees: Continue winter pruning of established fruit trees (not stone fruit) up until early March.

Grape Vines: Finish pruning by early January. Keep some hardwood lengths of stem. Cut at an angle just below a bud, and straight across just above a bud about 30cms (1 ft) up the stem. Leave on the bench in a greenhouse or shed for a couple of days then plant several in large pots of soil or compost. Keep watered, and they should be ready to plant out next Autumn.

Rhubarb: Start forcing rhubarb, either in a greenhouse or outdoors, for the first tender stems in the Spring. Exclude light either with a terracotta forcing pot or an upturned bucket or dustbin. Plant new dormant crowns, digging in plenty of well rotted manure or compost.

According to the textbooks rhubarb requires a rich moisture retaining soil, however rhubarb can't read, and I have found that it grows pretty well in Harling's' terrible thin Brecks soil!

Seeds: Catalogues are now mainly online, but worth a browse. Only buy from reputable seed merchants – if buying from eBay make sure that the seeds originate in the UK or Europe.

House plants: keep leafy tropical plants humid by placing on trays of damp pebbles to reduce the drying effect of central heating.

Birds and other wildlife: keep an ice-free water source for wildlife, and remember the birds when it gets really cold.



After 30yrs or more, I have decided to resign from delivering the Contact Magazine in our village, Bridgham.


