

Dear friends

I am writing the day after returning from Spain, having had a good few days of sun and relaxation.

I did intend to do more than I did – for instance, I had very clear intentions of doing a day trip in Barcelona, visiting the Sagrada Familia and Parc Güell and so on. I also had several books planned to read, and I just about managed two.

At one point, commenting on my lack of activity, defending myself I said, "I'm a human being, not a human doing." It's something of a cliché, but there is something important here. So many problems and difficulties are created by us seeing the world primarily in economic, productive terms. What is seen as valuable about you is what you can make, or produce, or provide ... instead of believing that you are valuable simply because you have intrinsic worth.

When people look at Jesus, they inevitably about the things he says, and the things he does. And these are obviously important. But it's interesting to notice how often Jesus does nothing, or refuses to explain himself fully. Jesus' authority and significance do not flow from what he achieves, or produces, or owns. They flow from his inner self; his wisdom, his unshakeable peace, his love of others (even when they don't deserve it), and his relationship with his Father.

So I come back from holiday, with all this in mind, ready to get back to work – it is still good to be fulfilling your role, getting on with the things that need to be done. But I also intend to do it from a place of peace, of rest, and of remembering that my own worth is not dependent on the things I do, but on the person I am, created in the image and likeness of God – and the same is exactly true of you.



CITIZEN SCIENCE EVENT AT ST PETER AND ST PAULS CHURCHYARD, EAST HARLING 15TH JUNE FROM 10 -12

East Harling Church's "Count on Nature" was held on Saturday15th June in the morning, an interesting and educational event for everyone. Lots of things were counted... insects, flowers, trees, lichen and much more.

Many Churchyards contain ancient wildlife meadows full of many different species, and are a rare and precious habitat. They have not been ploughed, fertilized or developed, lying undisturbed for centuries. They now make up a real haven for wildlife, for bees, butterflies, swifts, sloworms and hedgehogs, and many rare plant species.

Our Bioblitz event found 71 different species of plants and insects in the churchyard and uploaded them to iNaturalist. This App is very simple to use and a way for us to record our wildlife.

GREENER MONEY?

As Christians, we need to ask questions about how our money is being used. You may not think you have much money, so it won't apply to you. You may perceive it's really about 'investments', which only the wealthy have, or you don't really understand.

In fact, most of us do 'purchase' quite a few financial products and we can ask ethical questions, just as we do when we are buying our Fairtrade bananas. Bank accounts, insurance policies, pensions, student loans and mortgages are all financial products.

In 'putting our money where our mouth is' we can encourage good practices and 'divest' (or disinvest) from companies who don't share our values.

WHAT ARE YOUR VALUES?

The first thing to decide is what constitutes 'ethical' for you. If you know your values, you can then ask appropriate questions of potential and current financial suppliers - whether they are your bank, insurance company or pension provider.

Connect your faith with your money. Where is your treasure? Are you able to be generous? Can you spend wisely?

Many financial institutions are both big employers and big investors of cash. The way such companies behave should be as important to them as where they are putting the money under their stewardship. Some real questions to answer might be:

- Is it important to you how your bank treats its employees, how they support people on low incomes or the percentage of women on the board, even if this means a slightly lower return on your investment?
- Do you mind what your pension is invested in, provided your money is secure and will give you income in your retirement?
- Would a higher premium put you off an insurance company which has climate change and human rights high on the agenda?

WHERE IS YOUR MONEY NOW?

It's not always easy finding out information about the ethics of financial institutions. You can ask questions of your own providers and search for reviews online. 'Good with Money' recommends some ethical choices (see links at the end of this article).

Banks publish ethical policies on their websites. Take a look to see whether anything is said about the values important to you. For example, some banks might be keen to tell you about their workplace ethics but may be silent on how they deal with weapons manufacturers.

THE GARDEN IN JULY

I am writing this on a cold wet June day contemplating whether to read up how to grow rice or to get on and build an ark – Flaming June?

Lawns Grass growth slows down in the summer normally. Raise the mower blades which allows the grass to grow stronger to resist drought (you never know). If we do have a long dry spell keep the sprinkler in the shed, mains water is expensive and has a high carbon footprint. If you have a new lawn (seed or turf) you will need to keep them watered.

Shrubs Prune early flowering shrubs. Cut back some of the older growth of shrubs such as mock orange and flowering currant to new growth lower down the branch, then remove up to a quarter of the oldest stems at the base.

Cuttings Take cuttings of penstemons, salvias (including sages), rosemary and lavender. Take 10cm (4 inch) from current seasons non-flowering shoots. Put in damp cuttings compost in a bright place out of direct sunlight.

Hedges Cutting can continue. Watch out for birds' nests and wasps' nests

Roses Keep deadheading repeat flowering varieties. Leave single flowering varieties unpruned to allow rosehips to develop

Annuals Keep bedding displays watered in warm weather – they don't generally have much of a root run. In baskets and containers, they need watering daily. Feed weekly with a high potassium feed e.g. tomato fertiliser. Move pots out of the direct midday sun or you will cook the roots.

Perennials including dahlias Keep deadheading unless you want to keep the seed heads for the birds. Cut back hardy geraniums to get a second flush of flowers in early autumn.

Irises with rhizomes A good time to divide to improve flowering next year and to get new plants. Trim leaves to about 6 inches and replant with rhizomes showing

Fruit Blackcurrants can be pruned hard after picking. Red and white currants can be pruned to within two or three leaves above old growth. Select a few new canes from each summer fruiting raspberry after cropping and tie to wires for next years fruit, cut the rest down to ground level.

Prune stone fruit trees on a hot dry day so that the wounds seal quickly to prevent the fungal disease silver-leaf entering.

Vegetables Start sowing for winter and spring. Sow spring cabbage, spring greens, Florence fennel, turnips, and winter salad. If you have a few climbing French bean seeds left sow them to grow through existing climbing beans – if the weather is kind, you will get a few fresh beans right through to the autumn. Sow last few summer lettuces and radishes

Plant potatoes for Christmas. Half fill a large pot or bucket with drainage holes in with compost and place a couple of egg sized potatoes in. Cover with a thin layer of compost and water. As growth reaches a few inches add more compost until the pot is nearly full. Keep moist. Remember that you will need to protect from frost, so place where you won't need to lift a heavy pot full of compost and plants. Maris Piper, Nicola and Charlotte are good varieties for this.

Netting If you have bird netting tighten it up to prevent birds getting tangled up



WHICH REPORT CONVEYANCING FRAUD

Fraudsters are impersonating solicitors and making away with victims' house deposits just before their completion dates. This scam is known as conveyancing fraud, and it's typically executed by a fraudster hacking into a solicitor's or buyer's email account and providing alternative bank details for deposits to be paid to.

Lloyds Bank has warned that it received 29% more reports of conveyancing fraud in the second half of last year compared with the first half. It also found that victims lost an average of £47,000 and around 45% of victims were aged 39 or under, signalling that first-time buyers may be most at risk.

While either the solicitor's or the buyer's email account can be hacked for the scam to happen, the Solicitors Regulation Authority stated that it's nearly always the buyer's email that gets hacked due to the lack of firewalls that businesses have. After hacking either email account, a fraudster will monitor email discussions about the property purchase. When the time comes to transfer the deposit, the fraudster will either provide fake bank details from the property solicitor's email address or pose as the solicitor from an email address that looks very similar.

If they create a fake email address impersonating the solicitor, it may only have one character that's different from the genuine address and the email will copy the tone, email signature and even logos used in previous messages.

Sometimes the fraudster will call the buyer, impersonating an employee at the solicitor's office and provide bank details this way. Either way, victims of conveyancing scams are convinced to transfer money from their bank accounts to that of the scammer. This is known as an authorised push payment (APP) scam.

Buying a new home is stressful, and fraudsters rely on you being in a hurry. Follow these tips to avoid a conveyancing scam:

Transfer a small amount first. Before transferring your house deposit to your solicitor, send a nominal amount such as £1. Then, call your solicitor on its registered branch phone number to ensure it's received the money.

Double-check contact details. Be aware of any unexpected emails or phone calls, double-check email addresses for any new or missing characters and be wary if you're contacted by a 'new' member of staff.

Set secure passwords.

Avoid posting details online. Fraudsters can also look to social media to discover potential victims ready to make big purchases. So avoid shouting about your new home until it's secured.

Verify payment instructions. At the start of the process, confirm payment instructions with your solicitor in person or via a trusted phone number.

Pay attention to any bank warnings. If you're about to make a payment and you see that the account doesn't match the details of the receiving account, double-check this with your solicitor by calling them on a verified phone number.

If you become the victim of a scam, call your bank immediately using the number on the back of your bank card and report it to Action Fraud, or call the police on 101 if you're in Scotland.



WHY OUR FEET MATTER.....

Did you know that there are over 200,000 nerve endings on the soles of the foot? These nerve endings are part of our early-warning detection and defence mechanisms against foreign bodies. As our skin is the largest organ in our body, its function is to warn against heat, cold, sharp, and dangerous surfaces. Due to the feet being the furthest distance from our heart, they are often the first place that suffer when we have health issues such as Diabetes, Atrial Fibrillation, and Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) to name a few. Regular inspection of the foot can pick up on early signs of health problems and help keep feet mobile and active for longer.







