Dear friends

As I write this, we are just about a week's distance from the Coronation of King Charles III and Queen Camilla. It was an amazing occasion and, personally, I will remember so much about the music in particular. It is hard to hear the opening bars of Zadok the Priest and not be moved, I always think.

It was also wonderful to be part of the celebrations in East Harling – a short service of prayer and thanksgiving on the Recreation Ground, followed by the festivities – just wonderful to be part of such a beautiful village, and such a lovely community.

However, life continues on, and time gives us the opportunity to reflect. Most of the symbolism and the ritual of the Coronation was specifically Christian, and therefore was meant to relate to Jesus Christ. Of course, it's tangled up with political power, and with the display of wealth and strength too. But I do have to confess that it highlighted the difference between kingdoms of this world, and the Kingdom of God.

Jesus was crowned, but not with gold and precious stones. His crown was of thorns, pressed down upon his flesh. Jesus was dressed in a royal robe – but only so that he could be mocked, struck and spat upon; and then the robe was torn from his body. Jesus was enthroned – but it was not a gilded chair with a velvet cushion; instead, he was nailed to the rough wood of the cross. And crowds did gather – but to mock, and despise their King.

But the other difference is that all kings and rulers of this world can only hold on to power for a time – and, in the end, it makes just a small impression on the course of history. As a Christian, I believe that Jesus' Kingship is over all things, and for all time. And it isn't a reign that is about power and might; but about service, and the lifting up of the poor and the lowly.

Let's be honest – the Church doesn't always embody this perfectly, and I will be the first to confess that. The Church, and each individual, small example of a Church, is made up of flawed, imperfect human beings. But human beings who are trying to be active subjects of the King of Love, who calls us to realise our royal calling to be bearers of love, hope and joy wherever we may be.

So while I will continue to fulfil my Oath of Allegiance to King Charles III and his successors as a Priest of the Church of England, and as a British Citizen – it is not to a crown of gold, or a gilded throne or to robes of state that my commitment will be given. It is to a crown of thorns, to a cross of rough wood, to a human life unadorned by glamour and splendour – it is to the King of kings, the Lord of Love, the Great Shepherd, that I will give my life, and receive so much more in return. And that citizenship is offered to each and every one of us, now and always.

HARLING KENNINGHALL PRACTICE MAY COMMUNITY NEWSLETTER UPDATE

Following its installation in early March 2023, our new computer system is now fully embedded and operational and is helping us to manage the ongoing very high levels of demand. To quantify this level of demand, the Practice completed 4,137 appointments (from a total patient population of approximately 8,800) in February 2023, over 86% of which were conducted on a face-to-face basis.

Telephone waiting times have been reduced significantly following the implementation of same day appointments only being bookable by telephone before 10.00 am each day. This enables our Reception team to focus on answering incoming calls between 8.30am and 10.00am. Our Reception team answered 3,748 incoming calls during April, taking the 2023 yearto-date total for incoming calls answered to 15,809.

We continue to recruit to meet the growing demand. May sees an Advanced Practitioner starting with the Practice, along with an additional staff member taking up the newly created role of Prescription Clerk. In June we will have 2 new Reception staff joining the Practice.

Our Dispensary staff have also been very busy, dispensing over 11,000 prescriptions in April. As a reminder, we would ask that patients allow 5 working days for repeat prescription requests. These requests can be submitted online or by telephone, selecting option 2 (08:30-18:00 Monday-Friday, excluding Bank Holidays). Both Practice sites also have repeat prescription boxes inside and outside the buildings, enabling patients to drop in repeat prescription requests 24 hours per day, 7 days a week.

If any patients are still struggling with online access, patients can speak to Receptionists in person at either site who will be able to assist with the registration process.

Our Patient Participation Group (PPG) continues to meet every 6 weeks and we always welcome new volunteers for this group. Healthwatch Norfolk have recently visited the Practice, seeking feedback from patients at both Practice sites. We will be studying the report from Healthwatch Norfolk over the coming weeks as part of our continuous review process aimed at providing the best possible level of care to every patient.

Gardening in June



Lawns: Mow regularly. If you have a wild area don't cut until late July to allow annuals to set seed. If you need a new mower look at electric – they are more environmentally friendly than petrol.

Herb Garden: Plant thyme, marjoram and rosemary – their flowers are a magnet for pollinators. They can be in the ground, a pot, a window box or even a hanging basket. Plant mint in old buckets (they will eventually split them, so don't use an expensive pot). Keep different mints in different containers.

Continue to sow thinly in pots on a windowsill or in a greenhouse – parsley, thyme, chervil, basil, coriander, chives.

Annuals: Plant out any that are ready. Sow winter pansies by middle of the month.

Sow next years' flowers by middle of month at the latest: Spring flowering biennials (plants that flower and set seed in their second year), such as primroses, foxgloves, sweet williams and wallflowers can be sown now in trays or a seed bed ready to plant out in September.

Perennials: remove dead flowers to get a second crop of flowers in a few weeks.

Roses: Tie in new growth of ramblers and climbers as near horizontal as possible to encourage side shoots to produce more flowers.

Helebores: Look for self-seeded plants and plant out or pot up. They won't come true to the parent, but who knows they may be even better than the original.

Cuttings: Take softwood cuttings from new growth from shrubs and perennials. With the exception of fuchsias, (see below), the method is the same. Aim to collect cuttings

in early morning and place in a plastic bag to prevent drying out. Cut just below a leaf joint, remove lower leaves and plant several in a pot of free draining compost. Keep moist and warm and watch for roots coming from base of pot, and/or new top growth sometime in the next few months depending on the plant, and pot on into individual pots.

<u>Fuchsias</u> As above, but cut just above a leaf joint, and roots will form from the leg.

Strawberries: Watch out for mould if we get a damp spell. Remove any affected fruits.

Vegetables: Plant out marrows and other squashes and cucumbers and runner beans. It is not too late to sow more runner and French beans.

Continue successional sowing to extend the season of lettuce and radishes. (don't sow lettuce if very hot – it won't germinate.)
Plant out seedlings and young plants
Keep earthing up potatoes when growth above soil is about 8cm tall. Harvest anything that is ready.

Fruit: Cover redcurrants unless you are growing them for the birds! Harvest Redcurrants, Blackcurrants and Gooseberries when ready – probably towards the end of the month. Continue picking Rhubarb – if you have a glut clean, chop and open freeze in trays and store in pie/crumble amounts in plastic bags or containers for winter use.

Prune spring flowering shrubs as they finish flowering.

BARGAIN OF THE MONTH:

Keep an eye out around the village for plants and produce for sale outside houses in the village. Greenfields, Lopham Road, Church St and White Hart St all had some last time I looked!

Film and Exhibition Reviews (Thanks to BBC Iplayer and Norfolk Museums Service)



The film "Mr Jones" on the BBC I Player and available for over a year – is a chilling spy type drama set in 1933 and based on true events.

Mr Jones is an ambitious young journalist who gained some renown for his interview with Adolf Hitler. Thanks to his connections to Lloyd George, the former British prime minister, he obtains permission to travel to Moscow to interview Stalin. His aim is to find out more about the Soviet Union's apparently very successful economic expansion and Stalin's five-year development plan. Jones is restricted to Moscow but jumps his train and travels unofficially to Ukraine where he becomes the first person to collect evidence of and publish the events that led to the *Holodomor*, the deliberate starvation of the Ukrainian people then part of the Soviet Union...

Although this is a fictional account, Mr Jones is a real person, and the events that led to the *Holodomor* Stalin's man-made famine are true and occurred between the years 1932-33. The *Holodomor* has since been designated a Genocide.

Exhibition: The Last Voyage of the Gloucester – Norfolk's Royal Shipwreck 1682



On 6th May 1682 a royal warship the HMS Gloucester carrying James Duke of York, brother to King Charles II and heir to the English throne ran aground in heavy seas off Great Yarmouth on the Norfolk coast. Within an hour of striking the sandbank the

vessel sank causing many lives to be lost, and for over 300 years the wreck and its contents has lain buried on the seabed.

The Gloucester is now the subject of a major exhibition which explores the ship's dramatic discovery and displays for the first time some of the fascinating objects recovered from the wreck site. Most striking is the ships bell – that confirmed the ship's identity – which is on show alongside beautifully preserved personal effects, that tell stories of the passengers and crew, and of life on board the ship. James survived the ship's sinking to become King James II and VII in 1685.

The Exhibition is an amazing historical discovery, allowing visitors to make a real connection with people from the 17th Century through their personal items discovered at the wreck, and in my view is a must for weekend visits or the school holidays – tickets can be booked on line https://norfolk-museums.arttickets.org.uk/ or by phoning the Norwich Castle Museum: General enquiries: 01603 49362. Ramblings from Brettenham

What a difference a year makes! I really don't expect you all to remember what I wrote last May, so will just remind you of my previous wording...

Rain, rain come our way, the fields are dry, and the drilled crops are dormant in the seed beds. The grass is even showing signs of stress and the irrigators are already in use. There has been no heavenly water for over 30 days - the farmers and gardeners in the parish are very anxious.

Spring 2023 has certainly been very different, call it climate change or whatever, but we have had rain, rain and more rain which has meant that the drilling of the sugar beet, which normally happens around the 19th March, did not start until much later, in fact the majority had to be held back until mid-April, to make sure that the ground was in the correct condition to receive the seed and make sure growth would commence. The irrigators are all primed and ready to be used but at present there is no need as the growing conditions are fine, it is just great to see the land without the cracks and dust clouds which were part of life last year. Vegetable growing this year has been greatly reduced due to prices and other growing costs.

Nature has a wonderful way of adjusting to the various seasons of the year and I am sure you will all have noticed the amount of growth on the verges as well as the weeds and lawns in our gardens. It was shame that the daffodils and other bulbs seemed to have a short flowering period, but the later frosts and cold evenings did not help extend the flowering period. I hope that the frosts that we had early last winter have not killed plants in your gardens as it has done in ours. Even the rosemary which had been planted for over 20 years ago, as well as a cumquat tree which we planted from seed over 30 years ago, have sadly succumbed and brought sadness with it as well.

The birds are busy nesting, and I am delighted to note that we have a pair of buzzards in the garden. There is a chance that they may be the ones that we had in the garden and wooded area last year. I am sure that as we have several young rabbits, our garden might be a place to live quietly with a constant food supply not far away. They still make me stop and watch them as they call one another and glide through the thermals so effortlessly.

No events are planned to be held at the moment, but please keep an eye out for posters etc as we really do need to try and have a fundraiser and have the opportunity of getting together.

A Year in the Life of the Yorkshire Shepherdess by Amanda Owen


