

Dear friends and neighbours

We are drawing close to Lent, the season of the Church's year that is a time of reflection and preparation for celebrating the central moments of the Christian faith – the suffering, death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. How the date of Easter was determined, and why it changes every year is quite interesting but complex (if you want to know more, I suggest https://www.learnreligions.com/how-date-of-easter-is-calculated-542413). Where Lent came from is that it was a forty-day period (not including Sundays) for people who were preparing to be baptised on Easter Eve.

The specifics of that aside, it is good that the Church has this ebb and flow, this seasonality, built in. In normal human life, it is right and good that there should be times when we are busy, and there is lots to do ... but this really does have to be offset by times of rest and restoration. It is inevitable that there will be low moments, times of sadness, times of difficulty and of struggle ... but these do need to be balanced with moments of joy, pleasure and excitement. Do we ever balance them perfectly? Of course not – at least, I haven't worked out how to yet! But what the seasons of Advent and Christmas, Lent and Easter do for me is to remind me to try and ebb and flow with the seasons of the year, and the seasons of my own life.

Perhaps as we begin to see a bit more of the sun, the trees and shrubs begin to get greener, and we see the first hopeful signs of summer, it would be good to consider how you can attune to the rhythms around you and within you. Lent and Easter are the reminder that Death and Resurrection are *the* pattern – they flow into and out of each other. You are promised eternal life and joy because Jesus is risen from the tomb – but that joyful Resurrection was possible only because it followed on from his agony, passion and death. Denying either part of the equation knocks us off balance, and makes faith impossible ... but rising and falling in this world and into the next releases us to know God's pattern in our lives right here and now.

Every blessing for whatever season you find yourself in today



#### Wild Birds in Love

Love struck humans woo their beloved with a bouquet of flowers or a box of chocolates. Our wild birds have some very different tactics to win over the partner of their dreams. Some courtship displays, rituals or dances that you could see in late February into March are truly magical.

<u>Skylarks - virtuoso performers</u> – they are small brown birds, but when they open their beaks, their song is anything but boring! From late February onwards, males will fly high into the sky above farmland and grassland and



put on one of nature's most beautiful musical performances in the hope of impressing a potential mate. Skylarks have long inspired poets, composers and writers, from Wordsworth to Vaughan Williams. The male bird song floats down from high above, and mid-performance the male will plummet dramatically

down to earth before rising again and repeating the show over and over. These captivating – and physically draining – display flights can go on for more than an hour at a time and prove the male has the strength and stamina to make good dad material. You could spot Skylarks flying high above farmland, grassland, heathland and moorland almost anywhere in the UK.

<u>Great Spotted Woodpeckers - the ultimate head-bangers</u>. Instead of singing to attract a mate and advertise their territory, Great Spotted Woodpeckers take a slightly less subtle – and tuneful – approach by repeatedly bashing their beak against tree trunks. This creates a drumming



noise that echoes through the woods and can be heard by potential lovers and rivals a long way away. This head banging is the equivalent of repeatedly hitting a wall face first at high speed, but luckily for the woodpeckers, special shock absorbers in their heads help protect their brains from damage. Both male

and female woodpeckers will drum to establish their territories. Once a male has captured a love interest's attention, he might follow up with a spot of wing waving to show off his fine physique and seal the deal. Great Spotted Woodpeckers are widespread in woodlands across Britain. You might see them in parks and gardens with large trees too.

<u>Goldeneyes: dancing ducks</u> -with their dapper black and white body, iridescent head and gorgeous yellow eyes, male Goldeneyes are certainly dressed to impress the ladies. But it's not all about looks for these guys. They've got some pretty nifty dance moves too, and at this time of year lakes, lochs and reservoirs become the watery



equivalent of a dancefloor for ducks. Males will bob about looking for a willing audience before busting out their signature move – the head toss. This involves dramatically flinging their

head backwards, until it's resting on their body, beak pointing skywards. This peculiar performance is often accompanied by a croaky double whistle. If that doesn't do the trick to catch a female's attention, they'll take things up a notch and accompany the head toss with some frantic foot paddling, sending up a spray of water for extra dramatic effect. Who could resist? You can see Goldeneyes strutting their stuff at wetlands across the UK in winter.

<u>Mute Swan: iconic lovebirds</u> – For centuries, Mute Swans have been a quintessential symbol of love and devotion and it's not hard to see why. Each spring, pairs perform a



beautifully synchronised ballet out on the water, bowing to each other with wings held aloft, before entwining their necks, often forming a perfect heart shape. Mute Swans are a common sight on ponds,

lakes and rivers right across the UK, both in the countryside and in built-up areas.

Robins - gift givers The real food of love is a juicy earthworm (or beetle, or bug) — at least it is if you're a female Robin! Once a male has wooed a female with his song, he knows that gifts of food can help to cement their bond. So, when she's building the nest and incubating the eggs, he will deliver tasty morsels for her to snack on throughout the day. You might spot this courtship feeding in early spring, with the female shouting 'FEED ME!' in the form of a short sharp call and then quivering excitedly in anticipation of a tasty treat. This extra food can make a big difference to the pair's breeding success — a female will often lay more eggs if she's been well provided for by her partner. Robins are regular garden visitors, but you could also see them in parks, woodlands and scrubby areas.

#### GARDENING CLUB

In February we had we had a fantastic talk by Guy Barker which was in 3 parts. It started with his love or obsession with snowdrops. He had many varieties of snowdrop to show



us, ranging from the bog-standard ones costing a few pence each to some very exotic ones costing tens or even hundreds of pounds **for I bulb!** Some of them were his own discoveries. He was particularly smitten by Galanthus Atropos which clearly had the shape of scissors on its spathe (or centre section of the flower), named after the Greek god Atropos who was the Fate who cut the thread of life.

Next came a section of the talk on shrubs for winter interest — Mahonia, Chimonanthus (Wintersweet), Hamamelis (Witch Hazel), Daphne, Sarcococca humilis (Sweet Box), Viburnum and most amazing of all Parrotia persica (Persian Ironwood) which not only has fantastic autumn foliage but was in flower, with deep red flowers coming straight from the woody stems, at our meeting in early February.

Finally the whole was brought together with a slide show of the plants he had talked about in garden settings, mainly in Norfolk.If you didn't come – you missed a good one.

In March we have our AGM and social evening with wine and nibbles. We are reintroducing a table show which was a regular feature before Covid. If members want to take part just bring along a pot of spring flowering bulbs (Pot up to 6 inches (15 cms). We have a full program of talks lined up for the year beginning April (programme in next month's Contact). It was going to be in this month's issue, but I have taken up all my space waxing lyrical on snowdrops etc! See separate ad for our coach trip to Spalding Tulip Parade on 10 May on page 14.

#### THE GARDEN IN MARCH

I am writing this in mid-February when we seem to have had a proper winter. The snowdrops and aconites are in full bloom, and the



odd daffodil is in flower. There are buds and catkins appearing on trees, Winter is not over, but Spring is certainly on the way.

**Birds:** March is the beginning of the main breeding season. Leave out materials such as wool, fresh straw, animal hair etc. as nesting material. Keep a water source topped up for them.

Lawns: Walk on as little as possible until they become less waterlogged. When they are reasonably dry rake to get rid of moss and dead grass. If you have, and want to keep, a pristine monoculture lawn apply a weed and feed at the end of March. If like me, you are happy to have a more natural lawn leave out the weeding and feeding and wild flowers will appear as if by magic. If you laid a new turf lawn last month watch the weather and water if necessary. If you intend to sow a new lawn, start getting the ground ready. Hoe to remove any weeds and rake several times during March with a view to sowing mid-April. 13

**Patios:** Scrub to get rid of dirt, moss and weeds which are not only unsightly, but can make them slippery.

**Pruning:** Prune hardy fuchsias, buddleias and finish pruning roses. At the end of the month cut back shrubs grown for the winter colour of their stems such as dogwood (cornus) and willow (salix).

**Perennials:** Clean up perennials and finish removing any dead or diseased material. There is still time to split established plants and to plant new ones.

*Tip*: Don't forget the gardening club Plant sale in May.

**Gladioli:** Plant 4 to 6 inches (10 - 15 cms) deep. <u>Tip:</u> If you plant a few every couple of weeks until the end of June they will flower over a much longer period.

**Dahlias:** Plant tubers in pots or trays in a frost-free, well lit room or greenhouse. They don't need heat. They can also be sown from seed in a warm place from the middle of the month.

**Begonias:** Gently push begonia tubers into pots or trays of damp compost with the hollow side up. Keep in frost-free, bright and warm conditions to encourage new growth.

**Annuals:** Hardy annuals can be sown outside now. Half-hardy annuals can be sown on a windowsill or in a greenhouse, protected from frost, from the middle of March. Watch the weather forecasts, we will have every sort of weather this month. On warm days ventilate your greenhouse.

Vegetables: Tip most packets of seed contain far more than you need. If kept sealed, cool and dry most seeds will remain viable for several years (not parsnips). Tip: If you sow 100 lettuce seeds all at once they will all need pricking out all at once and will all be ready over a 3-4 week period, Sow a few at 2 week intervals. Sow peppers and chillies on a warm windowsill or in a heated greenhouse. Sow under glass without heat: Brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflowers leeks and peas, and in late March tomatoes. Sow outdoors (when soil is neither frozen nor waterlogged): carrots, and radishes. Plant early potatoes. Harvest whatever is ready. Remember that when the temperature warms up many overwintered crops like kale and leeks will flower and only be good for the compost heap.

Compost: Peat based composts are no longer available for domestic use. Many of the composts that we trialled at the Garden Club have been tweaked by the manufacturer (and hopefully improved). I am trying several different ones and will report in a later issue of CONTACT. When buying compost try to avoid ones containing coir (basically the hair from coconuts). When comparing prices bear in mind that the large bags are generally in 40 or 50 litre bags, and often at similar prices.

**Pots and Tubs:** March is a little early for annuals, but you can start them inside and plant them into the tubs later.

**General:** On warm dry days hoe off annual weeds in beds and borders as they start to appear. Good gardening






