EAST HARLING & KENNINGHALL MEDICAL PRACTICE NEWSLETTER UPDATE - NOVEMBER 2022

We have experienced another very busy month at the Practice. So far, approximately 1,750 of our patients have received their flu vaccinations, the majority of which have taken place during 3 Saturday mornings during October and November. Our staff volunteer for these Saturday rotas in order that the flu vaccinations do not reduce the number of available appointments during the week. A further 500+ flu vaccinations are scheduled for an additional flu clinic on Saturday 26th November.

In addition, we have been working hard to ensure our housebound patients and care home residents have received home visits to receive their flu vaccinations and Covid-19 boosters.

During October we held our Patient Participation Group (PPG) information evening, and the first formal meeting of our relaunched PPG will take place at East Harling on 22nd November. The PPG will be actively involved in writing newsletters and reviewing patient feedback with some of the Practice management team.

There continues to be an extremely high demand for appointments, and it is therefore more important than ever that patients contact us in advance if they are unable to attend an appointment. Even if you become aware that you are unable to attend an appointment at very short notice, and let us know, we are still highly likely to be able to offer another patient this cancelled appointment. Unfortunately, 154 appointments were lost in October because we received no cancellation advice.

We always welcome patient feedback and your ideas on how we can continually strive to provide the best possible patient care. We have been reviewing recent patient feedback on our telephone system, which will be upgraded early in the New Year to eliminate the issues we have occasionally experienced with calls being cut off. In addition, to help manage incoming call volumes, we are now asking patients requesting repeat prescriptions to order these via our website wherever possible. If you have no internet access, then repeat prescription telephone calls should be made between 10:00 and 1.00pm Mondays-Fridays. Please remember to allow 3 working days for repeat prescriptions. covered poles ("Ale Stakes") were raised outside inns to show that that good wine could be found within. Ivy has long associations with pagan and Christian festivals at

this time of year, remaining green and producing flowers when most plants have gone to sleep.

<u>Outside Taps</u>: Turn them off from inside if you can, if not insulate them.

Lawns: This year is a bit different to the textbooks. Having more or less died off in the Summer drought the grass has been rejuvenated by the October warmth and rain. As I am writing this in early November the lawns and verges are full of Spring growth of wild flowers that managed to thrive with no competition from the grass. From my viewpoint this is good, and a mow with the blades set high when weather permits will encourage nature to do its thing (compost the mowings). The grass is growing equally rapidly, and if you want a flat monoculture grass lawn it is a bit more tricky. When the grass is dry cut to about 5cm high which reduces the risk of disease, but gives enough top growth to withstand very cold weather. Weeding and feeding will have to wait until the Spring. Whichever sort of lawn you want continue to remove dead leaves regularly. Norfolk Wildlife Trust Breckland Local Group

<u>Trees and shrubs including roses</u>: Continue to plant bare root plants when there is no frost in the ground. Stake taller plants and check from time to time, firming the ground around them if they are moved by the wind.

<u>Cuttings</u>: Hardwood cuttings of trees and shrubs can still be taken.

Short plants: Don't let them get covered with leaves.

<u>Vegetables</u>: Continue to harvest whatever is ready.

<u>Fruit trees</u>: Continue winter pruning established fruit trees and bushes (not stone fruit) until late February.

Finish pruning grapevines by early January. Keep some lengths of the woody prunings and place on

the bench in a cold greenhouse or shed for a few days, then cut into 30 cm lengths. Cut at an angle

just below a bud, and straight at the top just above a bud (this way you will know which way up to plant them) plant several in a large pot or in a cutting bed, label and keep watered and weeded throughout the summer and they should be ready to plant out next Autumn.

Bulbs: It is still not too late to plant daffodil and tulip bulbs - garden centres should be selling them off, so keep an eye open for bargains. Check potted bulbs planted in September and move any that are ready to an unheated greenhouse, cold frame or cool windowsill.

BOOK REVIEWS - Thanks to Liz!

I have just finished the debut novel of **Ruth Hogan** "The **Keeper of Lost Things**" first published in 2017 to become a Sunday Times best seller.

Stories intertwine when an author carries on a habit of a lost love, picking up lost articles he notices and secretly keeping them with description and details of location found in hope of future return to owners. It becomes clear he had written fictional stories of how he thought these things might have been lost and who they belonged to. These stories are insightful in bringing other characters of the story together with lots of humour involved.

(This edition was from 2021 where her additional three novels were also listed and include: The Wisdom of Sally Red Shoes 2018; Queenie Malone's Paradise Hotel 2019; & Madame Burova 2021.

Sheila Hancock's 2014 'Miss Carter's War' is the story over decades of a young enthusiastic teacher becoming one of the first women to receive a degree from the University of Cambridge as a former SOE behind enemy lines. It goes through her lifetime of changes through the education system and the friendships along the way. (Found it touched on many parts of society that also met changes over her Majesty's Reign.)

'My Kind of Happy' by Cathy Bramley is a 2020 tale of dealing with grief and finding one's true self. When character Fearne makes a chance discovery she decides to start a happiness wish list. Stepping out of her comfort zone and into the unknown world treasuring memories of her beloved grandmother's floristry and helping her to arrange beautiful blooms that brought joy to their recipients. (This certainly touched my soul having also lost my brother under similar circumstances and our own love of beautiful gardens from our mom and hers! Will always treasure memories of our Mom's first flower arrangements and developing her own 'native garden'!)

I just finished **The Turning Point by Freya North** which I loved! Two very talented people meet by chance in London, a children's book author relocated to North Norfolk with her two school aged children and another single parent musician from British Columbia, Canada. All the scenic depictions were wonderful! Their relationship and career struggles very interesting as well.

"A Few of the Girls" - Short stories of Maeve Binchy, her husband and editors published in 2015.A very nice bedside read with forty-one thought provoking tales.

Communities in Christ, working together

One of the first pieces of guidance to reassure new churchwardens at the start of a Diocesan workshop is "don't worry, every church's quinquennial identifies at least £250,000 of repair costs, but the church has survived many centuries and is still standing". In addition, delegates are reminded that, as communities of faith and practice, we are stronger working together.

Holding on to these happy thoughts, Wilby's newly appointed churchwarden started his tenure in 2018 but soon realised that the chancel roof and ceiling posed a very real challenge to the integrity of the church's fabric. A call to the extremely supportive and experienced diocesan Historic Church Building Support officer (HCBSO) produced a strategy for raising the £170,000 required. The first step was to decide whether to go down the National Lottery Heritage Funding (NLHF) route, or to approach grant funding charities.

Thankfully one of our benefice churches had almost reached the end of their repair project generously funded both by the NLHF and the National Churches Trust. Their project coordinator was kind enough to talk Wilby's team through the advantages and disadvantages of both approaches, and made the process of seeking funding far less daunting that it first appeared. Once the decision had been made to proceed with grant funding charities, ten funding bodies were identified and a strategy for approaching them was provided by the wonderful HCBSO.

The applications received remarkable support from the charities. The Norfolk Churches Trust and the National Churches Trust have been particularly generous and understanding of Wilby's service to local and wider communities. For example, tackling rural loneliness and isolation, and offering lifelong learning opportunities for young people and adults.

The work was split into three phases: Phase I urgent minor repairs - £15,000; Phase II surveys and investigations - £16,000; and Phase III major repairs. Phases I and II are now completed and the architect's certificate of completion issued.

Putting the applications together has only been possible by networking and engaging with parishioners and also with people with skills available within the various communities – benefice, deanery and diocese.

Thanks to the extraordinary efforts by ordinary people, we are now within £35,000 of our target and awaiting the results of recent applications to several new charitable bodies to close the funding gap. If all goes well, we may be able to commission Phase III work to begin early in the New Year. We are truly blessed being members of such wonderful communities.

In the Spring of 1970, one of the finest Anglo-Saxon artefacts ever discovered in Norfolk, was found in a daffodil field next to Lading Church. This has become known as the "Lading Plaque". It has been described, in "A History of Norfolk in 100 Objects" by John A Davies and Time Pestell, as being carved out of whalebone, of high status and fine workmanship.

There are two detailed reliefs (two more have broken off and are lost). To the right is a winged and maned creature, biting its' interlaced tail in a style characteristic of 8th To the left is a depiction of Century Art. Romulus and Remus, the legendary founders of Rome, being suckled by a she-wolf. This same motif was used on coins of the Anglo-Saxon King Ethelbert of East Anglia. Ethelbert was murdered in 794 by King Offa of Mercia, a political rival. Ethelbert was subsequently made a saint, and Larling Church is dedicated to him. This panel may mean there was an earlier church on the site, which was associated with East Anglian royalty. King Ethelbert had a connection, possibly through bloodline, to the Roman Occupation. He was likely to have been proud to show off Romulus and Remus as a type of status symbol to prove this link, hence the twins on his coinage. There is also reference to the royal family being known as the Wuffingas or "Kin of the Wolf".

We will never know if Ethelbert walked the fields of Lading. Was he a local? It would be good to think so. Also who was the craftsman who made this tiny detailed plaque?

The plaque has been on show in Durham Cathedral, in Thetford museum and at Sutton Ho. It is lodged at Norwich Castle Museum and is displayed on a regular basis.




