

Dear friends

As I write, we are about to enter the season of Lent. The core message of this season is 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near.' (Matthew 4.17). There are three points I would like to share from this.

'Repent' – don't worry, I'm not about to put you on a guilt trip! The word Jesus says here is 'metanoeite', and what it means

is 'change your mind, your attitude, your worldview.' The war in Ukraine, the imbalance of people struggling to heat their homes while oil companies rake in record profits, and the culture of bullying and 'cancelling' – even the Church's attitude to LGBT+ people – all of these are instances where hardness of heart, selfishness and lack of compassion make the world a colder, harder, sadder place. To allow love, joy and hope to change our viewpoints (whether Presidents, CEOs, Archbishops – or we ourselves) is the repentance that Jesus gently invites us to. How much more beautiful would your world be, if you 'changed your mind', or 'repented'?

'The kingdom of heaven' – this isn't a place, or a tyrannical rule – it is biblical language for

the presence and the kindness of God. Jesus calls people to repent because, in him, that presence and kindness can be seen. Most of you reading this will probably not be interested in religion or church — I'm not sure Jesus was overly interested either. Rather, he was passionate about justice, about mercy, about freedom, about inclusion, about genuine human encounter ... rather than anything 'religious' or vaguely 'spiritual', this kind of acceptance of the other is what the kingdom looks like. In real terms — Jesus wants each one of us to know how passionately and totally we are loved by God, and infinitely worthwhile.



And lastly, 'has come near.' Where religion, spirituality, church, etc. can come into play is in helping us to see this. Seeing is perhaps the most important concept Jesus shares in the Scriptures. All that I've already written is all well and good, but how can we know and understand it for ourselves. The answer is very, very easy – and the practice of a lifetime. By opening our eyes to the goodness in those around us; in the natural realm in which we live; by reading the Scriptures, by praying (whatever that might mean to each one of us) – if we will 'open our eyes' and just become more aware of everything we have, everything we are, everything around us, then glimpses of heaven start presenting themselves to us wherever we are.



In this Lenten season, perhaps you could take a moment to ponder how you might change your outlook, and let your heart be changed; understand how much you are worth to the one who created you; and see afresh the love that is around you, and the need for you to be the presence of love in your world.

THE GARDEN IN MARCH

The next 3 months are where you lose those extra winter pounds ready for mid-June when you can sit in your garden with friends and barbecue with a glass of your favourite tipple.

As I write this in mid-February the birds are singing earlier until later, there are already a few wild Spring flowers and snowdrops galore - seems a particularly good year for them.

Evergreen trees and shrubs: Many normally evergreen shrubs and trees made it through the extreme heat of the summer, but went into winter stressed. Looking around the village many lost their leaves during the hard frosts of late January. Be patient it is a survival strategy by the plants. Wait until mid-May before deciding what to do with them. Some will grow new leaves over most or all of the plant. Some will send out new growth from around the base, and sadly some will not make it and will need to be replaced. In May trim any dead wood away, and give a foliar feed to those that have survived.

Deciduous trees and shrubs: Many of these lost their leaves early and went into winter stressed. Most will come back in the spring. As with the evergreens trim away dead sections in late May and give a foliar feed.

Lawns: Rake to get rid of dead grass and moss. Apply a weed and feed late in the month. A good month to lay turf (not when there is frost on the ground). Continue to prepare ground for sowing NEXT MONTH.

Patios: Scrub to get rid of dirt and moss which can make them slippery.

Pruning: Prune hardy fuschias and finish pruning roses.

Perennials: Clean up perennials and finish any removal of dead material. It is not too late to split established plants. Plant new perennials.

Tip small plants from garden centres establish quicker than larger ones and in a couple of years will be as big and healthier than large, more expensive ones.

Tip2 Look around the village – there are several stalls with people selling surplus plants at a fraction of the garden centre prices

Tip 3 don't forget the Gardening Club plant sale in May.

Dahlias: Plant tubers in pots or trays in a frost free, well lit room or greenhouse – they don't need to be hot. They can also be sown from seed in a warm place from the middle of the month.

Gladioli: plant 4 – 6 inches (10-15cm) deep *Tip* If you plant a few every couple of weeks until late June they will flower over a much longer period.

Annuals: Hardy annuals **c**an be sown outside from now, half hardies in pots or trays protected from frost from the middle of the month – watch the weather forecasts we can have some very strange weather in March. On warm days ventilate the greenhouse.

Vegetables: *Tip* Most packets of seeds contain far more than you need. If kept cool and dry, and resealed most seeds will remain viable for several years (not parsnips)

Tip 2 If you sow 100 lettuce seeds at once they will all need pricking out at once, and all be ready over a 3-4 week period – sow a few at 2 week intervals.

Sow peppers and chillies on a warm windowsill or in a heated greenhouse.

Sow under glass without heat: brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflowers, leeks, peas and tomatoes (late March).

Sow outdoors (when ground is not frozen or waterlogged): carrots, radishes and

Plant early potatoes. Harvest whatever is ready – remember when the weather warms up many of the overwintered crops like kale and leeks will flower and become only good as compost.

Pots and Tubs: If you have an established pot of shrubs now is a good time to scrape away as much loose compost from the top as will come away easily, and replace with new compost. If you are choosing a new container make sure it has a reasonably sized drainage hole. Use a good quality compost — that is all your plants will have to grow in this year — they can't spread out their roots to find food and water as they would in the ground.

Fill and plant up the tub where you want it to grow – the pot is probably quite heavy and so is the compost! If you are using a plastic pot use a soil based (John Innes) compost to stop it blowing over.

Remember the 7 inch rule (an inch of water will soak 7 inches of compost), so leave a gap at the top for watering. The 2 ways to make your plants struggle and under -perform or even die are too much water and not enough water. Filling your container with water once a week and letting it drain is better than a sprinkling daily.

If planting for summer don't be tempted to overfill - small annual plants want to grow fast.

March is a little early for annuals, but you can start them inside and plant them into the tubs later. The last few summers petunias and lobelia have struggled with the heat whereas begonias have done extremely well – you can plant corms in pots now to plant out in May, or buy ready grown plants from May onwards.



NOTES FROM THE GOVERNING BODY EAST HARLING PRIMARY SCHOOL AND NURSERY



On 22nd + 23rd November 2022, the School received its latest Ofsted inspection, the official report of which was published on February 1st.

The School Leadership team, staff and Governing Body are all very proud for the School to have received a unanimous 'Good' judgement, a culmination of over a year of hard work in developing and delivering a new curriculum.

Ofsted commented that 'Pupils are proud of their school' and 'Warm relationships between staff and pupils reassure pupils that they are safe and listened to'. Pupils said that the best things about the school are 'Teachers and friends'. Ofsted also reported that pupils are enthusiastic about learning and find the topics they study in the new curriculum interesting, and that school leaders have 'Grasped the nettle of curriculum improvement'. Ofsted also commented that 'Staff are well trained' and give extra support to pupils who need to catch up. Leaders have created a new reading curriculum that helps pupils to develop their reading fluency and introduces them to more sophisticated texts. Provision for pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) is a strength at the school.

We as Governors place a premium on Safeguarding provision, and Ofsted reported that arrangements for safeguarding are effective and that Governors, school leaders and staff know the signs that pupils might be at risk of harm. They know how to report concerns and how to secure help for vulnerable pupils quickly. Safeguarding records are detailed, thorough and regularly checked.

Through the school's holistic, nurturing approach, a programme of personal development prepares pupils for future responsibilities in a diverse world.

The Governing Body are now actively assessing and monitoring the implementation and impact of the new curriculum, through regular meetings with the senior leadership team and in school monitoring visits with subject leaders.

All Governors at East Harling are extremely proud of our school and feel very privileged to represent the pupils, parents and wider school community. We exist to help the school deliver its vision and ethos, support and challenge its senior leadership team, and provide financial scrutiny and budgetary value for money.

We would both like to state, on behalf of the Governing Body, our sincere gratitude and thanks to all staff over the last 16 months for their dedication, determination, and hard work. East Harling is very lucky to have such a wonderful school.

The start of the New Year has seen further initiatives to increase patient access with the start of 1 Saturday clinic per month. Everyone at the Practice is working very hard to ensure that disruption to patient services is kept to a minimum during this time, but please be aware our staff will be operating a completely new computer system from 1st March onwards. Consequently, your patience and understanding will be much appreciated during this time. Our newly re-formed Patient Participation Group (PPG) held its first meeting of the year in January. Items discussed included Winter pressures, the high demand for appointments, the high number of appointments booked but not attended, and further suggestions for enhancements to our telephone system. Our next PPG meeting will be held on Wednesday 8th March at 6.15pm at our East Harling practice site.

There were unfortunately 149 appointments lost during January, an increase from the 136 appointments in December, where booked appointments were not attended, and the Practice was not advised beforehand. This is the equivalent of 1 GP's appointments for almost 1 week.

Some of the books mentioned below are available in the Harling Book Swop or from a library or bookstore.

The Happiest Man on Earth, the Beautiful life of an Auschwitz Survivor by Eddie Jaku

Sometimes, reading big books is daunting. This one is for you as it is only 208 pages long with large text and some fantastic family pictures. There is no real need to describe it as the title is self-explanatory. The Harling reading group recommended this book and undoubtedly caused a mix of views.

I would much prefer to read his books than to see him in the kitchen". She is right. The quality of Nigel Slater's writing is just magical reading. He describes methods and ingredients so well that you can almost visualise them. A great read, the book you can quickly dip in and out of. This perfectly describes what it feels like to be in the middle of winter in the UK.

Missing on Dartmoor by Julian Mitchell

This was a new author to me, but it came highly recommended by a friend. She was right. I finished this in one day, which was unheard of for me. It was compelling. A crime book featuring a new detective with a different way of working than other detective novels I often read. It was a gripping story, and I wanted to know "who did it". I found it surprising that it was "that person". I won't spoil the surprise.

My only negative thought about this book is the size of the font. I understand that sometimes typesetters get the size and type of text wrong. Initially, this was hard to read due to the typeface. Every time I picked it up, I got frustrated that it was in the wrong font. Thankfully it was a book I wanted to read. 
